

From Tuscarawas County, Ohio Cemeteries - Volume III
Located in Salem Township, Tuscarawas County, Ohio

- SA85 Bethel Cemetery
Take County Road 21 (Stonecreek Road) south from Stonecreek to Township Road 226 (Bethel Hill Road). Take Township Road 226 west for about 1/4 mile, cemetery is located on the north side of the Township road. [T.6, R.3, S.8, NE comer of section.]
Coordinates: N 40° 20' 59.75", W 81° 34' 22.62"
- SA85A Dallas Cemetery
Take County Road 24 (Bunker Hill Road) from US Route 36 north of Port Washington to County Road 22 (Fry's Valley Road). Cemetery is located on the Norman property on west side of road a curve. [T.6, R.3, S.9, NE comer of section.]
- SA86 Centenary Cemetery
Take County Road 16 (River Road) south from Port Washington to Township Road 120 (Centenary Hill Road) east. It is located at the junction of Township Roads 120 (Centenary Hill Road) and 122 (Winding Stairs Road). [T .6, R.2, Lot 31, SE comer.]
Coordinates: N 40° 17' 38.55", W 81° 31' 7.53"
- SA87 Dye Cemetery
Take Township Road 220 (Glasgow Road) west from Port Washington, turn left on to County Road 23 (Wolf Road). It is near the junction of the two roads. [T .6, R.3, Lot 2.]
Coordinates: N 40° 19' 26.63", W 81° 33' 10.23"
- SA88 Mount Zion Cemetery
From Stonecreek take County Road 21 (Stonecreek Road) south to County Road 17 (Harmony Valley Road) west. Take Township Road 226 (Sigel Johns Hill Road) west to County Road 19 (Little Buckhorn Road) to Township Road 220 (Hawk Road) to Township Road 225 (Mt. Zion Cemetery Road) (about 1/4 mile to cemetery. [T.6, R.3, S.5, SE comer.]
Coordinates: N 40° 18' 8.85", W 81° 36' 9"
- SA89 Port Washington Cemetery (Union)
Located in Port Washington. Check Salem Township map in the front of this section for location.
Coordinates: N 40° 19' 35.58", W 81° 31' 22.56"
- SA90 Salem Cemetery (Moravian)
Turn left off US Route 36 on to Township Road 213 (Salem Park Road), just south of Port Washington. Township Road 213 ends across the railroad tracks. From here cemetery is located about 1/2 mile (walk) toward the Tuscarawas River in a com field. [T.6, R.3, Lot 10.]
