



Temperance Tavern, Olde Main Street Museum, and USS Radford National Naval Museum



Newcomerstown is home to three museums perfect for your next group tour stop. The Temperance Tavern is a large white former home and lodging for the Ohio-Erie Canal and Cadiz Pike travelers during the mid 1800's. Built almost entirely of Black Walnut, this preserved home still has the original tavern complete with the huge fireplace and walnut table where travelers relaxed after a hard day's travel. Visitors can view displays of hometown notables such as "Cy" Young and Woody Hayes. This building is not handicap accessible.

The Olde Main Street Museum houses a replica of Newcomerstown's Main Street from back in the late 1890's to the early 1900's. Some of our store fronts are of a bank, grocery store, hardware store, shoe repair shop, pharmacy, clothing store, harness shop, post office and many more. We offer local entertainment and luncheons upon request at an additional charge per person. We are handicap accessible with handicap restrooms.

The USS Radford National Naval Museum is owned, operated and maintained by the former officers and crew members of this famous destroyer that gained recognition during World War II, Korea, Vietnam and the Cold War. The Radford earned 26 Battle Stars during her 27 years at sea. Over 4,000 men had duty on this ship and it is one of only 19 destroyers to ever receive the United States Presidential Unit Citation. She spawned 10 men that advanced to the rank of Admiral during their naval careers and you will see their magnificent uniforms on display. Other displays include other ships from Destroyer Squadron 21, USS Helena CL 50 and HMSNZ Leander. Employees of the United States Congressional Library have stated we are on par with the Smithsonian for quality and the finest naval museum they have visited. Our current 5,000 square feet of carpeted display space is equipped with clean, handicap accessible rest rooms, cool drinking water and a place to relax. See all three museums in one stop! Allow about 2 hours to tour all three sites.
