Zoar is the site of a German Religious Communal Society which lasted from 1817 to 1898. Many of the distinctive German structures, built by the Zoar Separatists, are still standing. Some are privately owned homes, others contain shops, bed and breakfasts and restaurants while still others are owned by the Ohio Historical Society as a 10-building historic site now managed by the Zoar Community Association. The bakery now hosts a retail bakery in the historic building. The tin shop, blacksmith shop, and greenhouse still operate in their original capacity during special events and weekends.
